

It takes a lot of us to deliver this sit down dinner. If you worked it last year or attended this function, you found that it is a lot of fun to be part of it and the food was great! We hope that you will volunteer to help out, because without your help, we cannot do it. It takes approximately 45 people to work this event. We need help with selling tickets, decorating, desserts (which parishioners donate) and wait staff as well as beverage servers and of course, clean-up! We truly need your commitment!

Claudia Hale and Eric Chadwell are going to be back at the helm in the kitchen. There will be committees for decorating the Commons and also, a German potato salad committee that will make it (it is delicious!).

<u>September 24th.</u> This should give us time for selling the tickets, adequate time to be able to calculate the amount of food and beverages we will need to purchase and the time needed to shop for all of the items and food for this event. If we get the same reception as last year, they will be sold quickly. We will only sell 200 tickets and no more. I have already been asked, if we are going to hold this event this year, so there is interest.

The menu will consist of mustard pork loin, a bratwurst with sauerkraut and onions, red cabbage, German potato salad, roll, dessert, and beverages (water, lemonade, tea, wine and beer). Pretty good deal when you get all of this food and beverages and you do not even have to tip the great wait staff!! As in the past, we will be asking parishioners to bake desserts for this fundraiser. We thank you in advance for your generosity for the desserts you have provided in the past. We will be in the Commons at the end of mass the next few Sundays with volunteer sign-up sheets and tickets. Remember, it only benefits our church and it is to add monies to the capital improvement fund, which is for fixing/replacing the HVAC system and roof. Both of these items are aging. FdS Parish Financial Report

(Through the end of June 2023) Fiscal Year 2022-2023

Total Income: \$179,380
Total Expenses: \$184,112
Income - Expenses: -\$4,732

Total Offertory & Debt Reduction Budget: \$178,000
Total Offertory & Debt Reduction Income: \$168,623
Difference: \$9,377

As we reached the end of June, we completed our Fiscal Year. As you can see from the numbers above, our combined Total Offertory & Debt Reduction Income was \$9,377 Less Than our planned budget. As a result, when you look at total income versus total expenses, we are in the Negative by \$4,732. The continued deficit in income has been very concerning since it forces us to reach into our savings account to pay our bills so we can keep the Parish operational. To compensate for the reduced income that should be covering our mortgage and yearly bills, we made the decision to pay off our building mortgage with funds from our savings account. As we move into the next fiscal year, we are respectfully requesting an increase in Parishioner offertory support. Thank you for your continued support of our Parish!

The following are ways to continue your financial support to Church of Francis de Sales:

- 1. When attending Sunday Mass, you can leave your Sunday Offertory in the tall basket on the table by the Baptismal Font.
- 2. You can bring your Sunday Offering [i.e., envelopes, check, cash] to the Parish Office [Monday & Tuesday 08:00am to 04:00pm and Friday 08:00am to 12:00 noon].
- 3. You can send cash or checks to the Parish Office for each week.
- 4. If you pay bills online, please consider making your weekly/monthly Offertory an online payment or set up automatic bill pay.

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
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
