

What is CRS Rice Bowl? Annually the Church of Francis de Sales works with the Catholic Relief Services (CRS) to sponsor the Lenten Rice Bowl. The Rice Bowl is a Lenten Program for Catholic families to put their faith into action. By following the daily reflections and activities in the Rice Bowl Lenten Calendar, you can provide needed funds for families in need both globally and locally. Seventy five percent of Rice Bowl funds are spent globally, and twenty five percent will go for local needs.

The theme for the Rice Bowl this year is Bread of Life, as Jesus said in John 6:35 "I am the bread of life; whoever comes to me will never hunger, and whoever believes in me will never thirst."

Your donations can help families gain dignity and provide support for their family. Your donation of \$40.00 can obtain chickens to provide protein-rich eggs for one family, or \$80.00 can buy a goat that will provide milk and income or \$150.00 will build a garden for nutrition and income. All donations received small of large, will help our family around the world.

The Claude V. Simmons Scholarship Academic Year 2024-2025

The Claude V. Simmons Scholarship Fund supports graduating high school seniors who are obtaining a Bachelor's Degree by attending a 4-year college or university and are qualified active members of the Church of Francis de Sales in Mathews County, Virginia. This is a 4-year renewing scholarship.

Current recipients and new applicants must submit an electronic application or renewal application for the 2024-2025 academic year to the Mathews Community Foundation by Tuesday, *March 05, 2024 at 5:00 p.m.*

Supporting documents are required as outlined in the application form on the Community Foundation website (i.e., Student Financial Information Form as well as a statement of reflection on personal growth and faith as a parishioner of the Church of Francis de Sales).

On this page, students can access all the scholarship opportunities available to them by typing "Mathews" into the search bar. They will need to scroll until they find the Claude V. Simmons Scholarship, and there is a button that says "Apply Now," which will take them to our online scholarship's portal. They will need to create an account to apply, but if they are applying for multiple scholarships, they can use the same account to apply to them all.






