#### Introduction to the Liturgy of the Word:

What does it mean to see? How do we fail to see? Samuel saw the strong and imposing sons of Jesse, but failed to look into the heart of each one. Paul encouraged the Ephesians to live in the light of Christ, where they could see what was pleasing to the Lord. Jesus cured the blind man, who soon recognized Jesus as Lord, but others refused to see Jesus as anything but a sinner because he cured him on the sabbath. Listening to today's readings, let us note who truly discerns what they see, who fails to do so, and what makes the difference.




