

Introduction to the Liturgy of the Word:

"Taste and see the goodness of the Lord," we sing in the psalm today, an invitation to the sumptuous banquet God lays out for us. Wisdom provides one of her own in the first reading, presenting knowledge and understanding as a meal we're all invited to eat. Calling Himself the living bread come down from heaven, Jesus invites us all to eat His flesh and drink His blood, as we do in the Eucharist. As Paul advises the Ephesians, we give thanks always for this meal in which we physically taste and see the goodness of the Lord.




